

Bali life right at home

EVEN if you've never been to a Balinese resort, you can live vicariously when this spectacular home opens to the public later this year.

Still under construction, this Bali-inspired home in the Huntington Downs estate in Maudsland is tipped to be the Gold Coast's most spectacular display home.

Designed and built by all-female company Brentnall Homes, the 'Inspirations' home will feature several connected bungalows spread over 850sqm, on a 4000sqm block with lush tropical gardens.

Brentnall Homes director Siobhan Pearson said the home was designed to mirror a luxurious Balinese resort day spa.

"We wanted the home to reflect the opulence and majesty of Balinese architecture to create a timeless design," she said.

A striking portico fronts the home, where bridges, glass floors,

and a running stream feature alongside timber accents and cathedral ceilings to create an authentic Indonesian feel.

A stone-clad fireplace and huge picture windows that overlook the resort-style pool add grandeur to the lounge room, while the master bedroom is a retreat of its own, with a fireplace, wood panelled ceilings and private balcony.

All five bedrooms will have ensembles and walk-in wardrobes, and there is a games room, sunken billiard room with a wet bar, top-notch media room and an office.

There is a separate guest house and the outdoor entertainment area includes a pool cabana, a kitchen and a fully equipped gym.

Ms Pearson said the home would have underground water tanks and solar panels. It will be available for sale on a leaseback arrangement.
