

Old world aesthetics inspires design

GOLD Coast builder Brentnall Homes has stepped back in time, but forward in design with its latest offering – an old English-style mansion with a modern colonial twist at Maudsland.

The architect-designed residence is taking shape on more than 1000sq m at Lot 71 Ginger Rogers Road in Tuxedo Junction estate.

It will have seven ensuite bed-

rooms, two outdoor entertainment areas with timber decking, a media room, billiard room, bar and walk-in cellar, four fireplaces and even a library and parents' retreat.

Even the roofing perfectly replicates old English style, featuring an authentic slat surface, complete with an upstairs attic and master retreat.

Features include 3.35m high ceilings, wrought iron race work and

posts, and 2.8m-high french doors.

Brentnall Homes co-director Darby Pearson said the inspiration for the design came from the desire to create an elegant home with old English influences, to bring a little of the past to the present.

“We wanted to replicate the beautiful structure and aesthetics from the olden days and bring it to today,” he said.
